## Nominations for National Bioscience Award for Career Development: 2012

The Department of Biotechnology (DBT) invites nominations of scientists who are engaged in basic and applied research in Biological Sciences including Biotechnology, Agricultural, Medical, and Environmental Sciences and have made outstanding contributions in research with potential for application/product and technology development, for 'National Bioscience Award for Career Development for the year 2012'.

The award is to recognize outstanding contributions of young scientists below 45 years of age in basic and applied research and to provide grant for research for their career development.

### Nature of the Award:

Up to 10 awards per year will be given. Each award carries a cash prize of Rs 100,000 and a trophy along with a citation and a project research grant of Rs 900,000 @ Rs 300,000 per year for a period of three years for career development.
