Applications are invited from eligible Indian nationals for two posts of Scientist 'C' (NFCCI) in Pay Band-3 Rs 15,600–39,100 + Grade Pay Rs 6600 and admissible allowances.

**Qualifications: Essential:** (i) 1st Class M.Sc. in Botany/Mycology/Plant Pathology/Biotechnology/Life Sciences; (ii) 4 years research experience in exploration, collection from field, *in vitro* culturing, handling pure cultures of micro and macro fungi, their identification using conventional and/or molecular tools as evidenced by publications in reputed journals.

**Desirable:** Ph.D. in Botany/Mycology/Plant Pathology/Biotechnology/Life Sciences.

**Job requirements:** *In vitro* culture, morphological and molecular identification/characterization of micro and macro fungi using conventional and modern molecular tools and techniques, *in vitro* culturing, optimization of culture conditions for their long-term preservation and maintenance.

**General conditions:**
