### Invitation for participation in Visiting Scientist Programme 2015

Since 1991, the INSA is supporting scientists from less endowed institutions to conduct advance research and training in advanced research institutions/laboratories within India under **Visiting Scientist Programme**. The main objective of the programme is to facilitate scientist to acquire furtherance of research capabilities for undergoing training in specific techniques, or utilizing facilities not available in their own institution. The scientist holding a regular position in R&D organization including universities or affiliated colleges in India are eligible to apply under the programme. The fellowship period varies from one month to six months depending upon the proposed work or purpose.
