Nominations/Applications are invited for the post of Executive Director (on deputation including short term contract), NABI, Mohali, Punjab, an autonomous Institute funded by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India. The goal of NABI is to serve as a Centre of Excellence in genomics, translational science and products development with focus on agri-biotechnology, food science technology, nutrition sciences and nutraceuticals.

1. Details of the post of Executive Director

Details of the job and other particulars of the post of Executive Director, NABI are given below:

- The Executive Director is expected to provide both academic and administrative leadership to the Centre in its intramural and extramural activities.
- The post carries a basic pay of ₹ 80,000/- with usual allowances as per Central Government Rules.
- Age (desirable): below 56 years.
- Scientists from Central/State Governments, Research Institutes, Autonomous Bodies etc.
 - Holding analogous post on regular basis in parent Department or
 - With 5 years' service in post with Grade Pay of Rs. 10000/- or equivalent in the parent cadre/Department and possess the qualification & experience as below:

Essential

- Ph.D. in food technology/biochemical or bioprocess Engineering or related field.
- Minimum 15 years research experience in the field of biotechnology, specifically for application in agriculture, food processing, nutrition and health.
- Excellent track record, hand in research publications, patents and awards.

Desirable

- Experience in successfully running large programme, centre, institution.
 - Experience of guiding research activities in relevant field.
- The period of deputation includes period of deputation in other ex-cadre posts, held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/Department should ordinarily not exceed 5 years. The maximum age limit for appointment (on deputation including short term contract) should not exceed 56 years as on closing date of receipt of applications.
