Research Staff Position under DBT Project

Applications are invited for a temporary position of Senior Research Fellow (01) in a DBT-CEIB II project entitled '**Functions of the multiple long noncoding transcripts of the *hsr ω* gene of *Drosophila***' @ Rs 28,000 p.m. + HRA. Research work would involve molecular, cell biological and genetic studies in *Drosophila*. The position is temporary and co-terminus with the project. Candidates must have at least two years' research experience after Master's degree (at least 55% marks) and at least one research publication in peer-reviewed journal in Life Sciences/Biochemistry/Biotechnology/Molecular and Human Genetics/Zoology or related area. Previous experience in molecular biology and/or *Drosophila* molecular genetics is desirable. The upper age limit for SRF is 32 years, relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST/physically handicapped/female candidates. All things being equal, SC/ST candidates will be preferred as per Gol rules.
