## **ADMISSION TO THE PhD PROGRAM OF MANIPAL UNIVERSITY**

We invite post-graduates with UGC/ CSIR - NET - JRF / ICMR - JRF / DBT- JRF / JEST / INSPIRE Fellowship or having qualified other UGC recognized national or state level eligibility tests with a valid fellowship to apply to the PhD program in areas of medicine, pharmacy, life sciences, allied health sciences, regenerative medicine, dentistry, public health, engineering and management at Manipal University.

### **Additional Support from the University:**

The University will support such candidates enrolled for the PhD program at Manipal University in the following ways:

1. The student will be paid a stipend of Rs. 14,000/- per month till he/she gets the fellowship from the granting agency.
2. Contingency grants of Rs. 1,50,000/- per year for three years will be given for research work of the student to cover equipment, consumables and publication costs.
3. Financial assistance to a maximum of Rs. 25,000/- for each student during the entire fellowship period, for presenting paper at the national/ international conference(s).

4. Candidates who have been selected under the above scheme are exempted from payment of course fee.

5. Candidates are exempted from the qualifying written test conducted by Manipal University and their selection would be by a panel of experts through interview.

### **Minimum Eligibility Criteria:**

Master's degree or a professional degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)
