## Call for Nominations for National Research Awards in Nano Science and Technology for the year 2018

The Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, under the Nano Science and Technology Mission (Nano Mission) has instituted 'National Research Award' and 'Young Career Awards' to recognize outstanding contributions of Indian Scientists to the advancement of Nano Science and Technology in the country as follows

Award category	Age limit (in yrs)	Award amount (in Rs)	No. of awards
National Research Award	Up to 70	100,000	1
Young Career Award	Up to 45	50,000	2

The date of reckoning for age limit shall be the closing date.

Nominees for the award should have made significant contribution in the area of Nano S&T.

Nominations of eligible Indian nationals are invited from Directors/Vice-Chancellors/Deans of academic institutions/government research laboratories or President/Past Presidents of national science/engineering academies. The nominations along with CV containing full details of their achievements, publications and contribution in the area of Nano S&T should reach the following address latest by **31 January 2018**.

### Goyal Prizes and Rajib Goyal Prizes 2016–2017

#### Announcement

Nominations are invited for the Goyal Prizes and Rajib Goyal Prizes for Young Scientists for the period 2016–2017. These prizes are instituted to honour Indian scientists who have made a mark in research in basic and applied sciences. The Goyal Prizes are awarded in the following four disciplines:

(i) Applied Sciences; (ii) Chemical Sciences; (iii) Life Sciences; (iv) Physical Sciences

While Goyal Prize in each discipline carries Rs Two lakhs in cash along with a medal and citation, Rajib Goyal Prize carries Rs One lakh in cash along with a medal and citation.
