Call for Nominations

Indian Peptide Society Young Scientist Award (IPS YSA) was instituted to recognize scientific excellence of young researchers with a proven record of independent works carried out in the country in the areas of peptides and peptidomimetics. The award constitutes a cash prize, citation and an award lecture to be delivered during the biennial Indian Peptide Symposium.

Nominations of individuals of below 40 years of age (as on 28 February 2019) from the Head of the Department/Institute are being sought for the award for 2019.

Nomination (only soft copy) must provide the following information:

1. A brief bio-data of the nominee with a proof of DOB, and names and addresses of three references.
2. A certificate from the Head of the Department/Institute certifying that the work submitted for the award has been carried out by the nominee in the country.
3. A brief description of the work (approx. 500 words) highlighting its implication/impact in the area of peptides.
4. A list of 5 best publications and their reprints (pdf files only; scanned copies in large sizes are not acceptable).
5. A complete list of publications, citation data (only number), if available.
6. Any other information to support the nomination.

Except the 5 reprints, all other documents, in the same order as listed above, should be placed in **one** pdf file only not exceeding 2 MB.
