Call for Nominations INSA Medal for Young Scientists – 2019

Since 1974, the Academy has instituted INSA Medal for Young Scientists with the aim of recognizing young scientists of extraordinary promise and creativity who have made notable research contributions in Science and Technology. This award, considered to be the highest recognition of promise, creativity and excellence in a young scientist, is made annually to those distinguished for these attributes as evidenced by their research work carried out in India. Only those born on or after 1 January 1984 are eligible for consideration in the year 2019.

The awardee shall receive a certificate, a bronze medal, cash award of Rs 50,000.

A candidate may be proposed by a Fellow of the Indian National Science Academy or by earlier recipients of this award. Scientific societies of national standing, university faculties, post-graduate departments or research institutions may also make nominations of eligible candidates.
