### Eleventh Indian Scientific Expedition to Southern Ocean/Antarctic Waters

National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research, Goa, an autonomous research organization of Ministry of Earth Sciences proposes to launch the 11th expedition in the ice free areas of the Indian sector of Southern Ocean (SO). The SO research programme is mainly focusing on the 'Role and response of Southern Ocean to the regional and global climate variability'. Duration of the expedition will be ~60 days. Launching of the expedition shall be in December 2019/January 2020.
