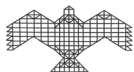

Essential qualification: Ph.D. in any discipline in Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities or allied fields.

Experience post Ph.D.: Minimum of 14 years for Professor, 8 years for Associate Professor and 2 years for Assistant Professor, in teaching and research.

Requisites and background: The applicant should be knowledgeable with relevant academic background in philosophy.
