



Current Science, an open access journal, endeavours to make scientific advances accessible to all. To build the capacity of scientists and researchers in India to write scientific papers in a manner that is understandable to non-specialist readers of the multidisciplinary journal, a series of Science Writing Workshops have been organized by *Current Science*.

The 11th Workshop in this series will be hosted by the Manipal College of Nursing, Manipal from 3 to 10 October 2019. Applications are invited from interested faculty in Indian universities, and scientists in Indian research institutes.

The Workshop aims to improve skills for writing different types of manuscripts, reviews and project proposals. The eight-day Workshop will be preceded by a month-long Virtual Online Workshop and followed by two-weeks online mentoring. The participants are expected to take part in online interactions actively.

Participant profile

- Ph.D. degree in any branch of science or three scientific papers in peer reviewed journals.
- Proficiency in spoken and written English.
- Knowledge in working with word processors and internet browsers.

Only 14 persons will be selected for the Workshop to allow group discussions, interpersonal interactions and hands on training. Arrangements will be made for the boarding and lodging of the selected participants.
