7–14 February 2020, Dibrugarh**

Current Science is organising a training Workshop on Science Writing in Dibrugarh, Assam for the benefit of scientists, researchers and science faculty in the North East. Dibrugarh University will be hosting this eight-day Workshop from 7 to 14 February 2020.

The Workshop aims to enhance the capacity of scientists and researchers to write different types of scientific articles and reviews as well as grant applications and project reports. To achieve this aim, the eight-day Workshop will be preceded by a month-long virtual online workshop. Selected participants are expected to take active part in the pre-workshop online interactions.

Participant profile

- Ph.D. degree in any branch of science or at least two scientific papers in peer reviewed journals.
- Comfort in working with word processors and internet browsers.

Only 14 persons will be selected for the Workshop to allow group discussions, interpersonal interactions and hands-on training. Arrangements will be made for the boarding and lodging of the selected participants.

Registration fee

Rs 10,000 (to be paid on selection) includes accommodation, food and workshop expenses.

Applications are invited from interested faculty in Indian universities, and scientists in Indian research institutes. Special consideration for applicants from the north-eastern states of India.
