

Invitation for Proposals to Host Workshops on Science Writing

Indian scientific output in terms of quantity is catching up with output from the developed countries. To improve the quality of scientific manuscripts from India, *Current Science* has been organizing training Workshops on Science Writing.

These Workshops enhance the capacity of scientists, science faculty and researchers to write different types of scientific articles, reviews, grant applications and project reports. To facilitate skill building, the intensive eight-day Workshop is complemented by extensive online interactions before the Workshop as well as feedback and mentoring after the Workshop.

Only 14 persons are selected for one Workshop to allow group discussions, interpersonal interactions and hands-on training. The Workshops are designed to be self-funded and have a registration fee of Rs 10,000 to meet Workshop expenses. Participants are also required to bear their travel expenses.

Current Science invites proposals from research rich institutions desiring to host such Workshops. The host institution should have adequate facilities for conducting the Workshop and for accommodating participants, trainers and resource persons. Up to four seats in the Workshop will be reserved for the host institution.
