National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research – NCPOR (erstwhile NCAOR), an Earth System Science Organisation (ESSO) under the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India is the nodal agency responsible for the planning, co-ordination and implementation of Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica.
