SRM Institute of Science and Technology invites applications for the post of Junior Research Fellow to carry out the project entitled '**Strategic Design of Oxygen Deficient Perovskites (Brownmillerites) as Bifunctional Electrocatalysts for Oxygen Reduction and Oxygen Evolution Reactions Occurring in Various Energy Devices**', supported by the Science and Engineering Research Board (Ref. No.: CRG/2019/003696) of the Department of Science and Technology under Core Research Grant (CRG) scheme.

Eligibility: First class M.Sc. (preferably in Physical/Inorganic Chemistry, Materials Chemistry).
