Basu Memorial Medal' for outstanding contribution in the field of ichthyology including original researches on pure and applied aspects of fishery. All members and Fellows of the Zoological Society and Indian Nationals are eligible. No candidate shall be eligible for the award more than once. The candidate must not be more than

35 years of age on the last day of February, 1989. The last date for the 1989 award is 28th February 1989.
