**Chemical Research Society of India (CRSI)\*** was established in 1999 to mark 50 years of the independence of India. The first National Symposium in Chemistry was held during 27–30 January 1999, at the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore. The major objectives of the Society are to recognize and promote high quality chemical research; improve the quality of chemical education at all levels; organize conferences, seminars, workshops, symposia and other similar programmes; foster talents in chemistry and chemical sciences; to interact and coordinate with industry to catalyse the growth of chemical industry and others.

The second meeting of the CRSI and the second National Symposium in Chemistry will be held in Hyderabad during 27–29 January 2000, at the Indian Institute of Chemical Technology. The membership is open to all scientists in India with specific interest in the growth of chemistry and its interactions with other disciplines of research – biology, physics, materials science and others. Research students of chemistry are also encouraged to become annual members/life members of the CRSI. Institutions and R&D establishments are welcome to join the society.
