Applications are invited for two posts of **Junior Research Fellow** to work under the National Agricultural Technology Project on 'Breeding and culture of pearl oysters and production of pearls' sub project on 'Mechanization and production of pearl nucleus'. The scheme is purely temporary and sanctioned for a period of three years. **Qualification**—(a) *Essential*: Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering/Production Engineering/Chemical Engineering; (b) *Desirable*: (i) Experience in design and development of equipment/machinery for food processing industries.
