

THE PROF. T.N. ANANTHAKRISHNAN FOUNDATION

Nominations are invited for The Prof. T.N. Ananthakrishnan Award from Indian scientists below 40 years (as on 31 December 2000) for his/her contributions to Entomology, for the work done in India.

1. Vice-Chancellors/Directors of research institutions/Principals of colleges/Head of Departments can nominate suitable candidates for the award. Please enclose a certificate of nomination with justification.
2. A brief note (500 words) on the achievements of the candidate should be enclosed along with the nomination.
3. Four sets of publications of the nominee, published in the last 10 years in support of nomination should accompany the nomination papers. Please enclose a curriculum vitae.
4. An independent jury consisting of three eminent entomologists of India, constituted by the Trustees of the Foundation, will evaluate the nominations and select the awardee. The jury's decision shall be final.
5. The award consisting of Rs. 5000 in cash, a silver plaque, and a citation will be presented in a simple public ceremony. (Date and the venue will be notified later).
6. Complete nominations with all enclosures must reach the Secretary, The Prof. T. N. Ananthakrishnan Foundation on or before 31 July 2000. For further details, please contact: Prof. M. C.
