- 4. An independent jury consisting of three eminent entomologists of India, constituted by the Trustees of the Foundation, will evaluate the nominations and select the awardee. The jury's decision shall be final.
- 5. The award consisting of Rs. 5000 in cash, a silver plaque, and a citation will be presented in a simple public ceremony. (Date and the venue will be notified later).
