Applications are invited for the position of Faculty Fellow (equivalent to Reader/Assistant Professor in a University/IIT) which carries a basic pay of Rs 12,420 (total emoluments being approximately Rs 20,112 per month) in the following areas:

- Evolutionary and Organismal Biology: The current research are in the areas of Chronobiology, Behavioural Ecology, Evolutionary Genetics and Population Dynamics. Persons interested in Whole Organism Biology including Invertebrate Neurophysiology are encouraged to apply.
- Molecular Biology and Genetics: The Centre has a strong presence in microscopy and is looking for persons interested in pursuing single molecule biology.
- **Theoretical Sciences**: Statistical Mechanics, Theoretical Computer Science, Mathematical Physics, Cryptography, Theoretical Biology, or any frontier area of contemporary interest.
- **Fluid Dynamics**: Persons interested in relatively unusual applications of CFD, for example in biological or geophysical problems including bird and insect flight, animal locomotion, clouds, plumes, etc. are encouraged to apply.
