Nominations are invited for Burhani Foundation – NEERI Award: 2001 for (1) Outstanding and Socially Relevant R&D in Environmentally Sound Technologies and (2) Innovation in Environmental Management/Conservation, which results in significant improvement in environment. The award consists of a citation and cash prize of Rs One lakh. The Scientist/Technologist can be nominated by Vice Chancellors of Universities/Deemed Universities; Chairman, UGC; DGCSIR/ICAR/ICMR/DRDO, Presidents of approved scientific societies and academies of all India nature, Secretaries of S&T Departments such as DST, DBT, DSIR, DOD, MNES, MOEF, Atomic Energy and Commerce and Industry Ministries, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Human Resource Development; Member Planning Commission (Science). Nominations will be accepted on prescribed proforma. The nominee in the first category will be an individual while nominee for second category can be an individual or an organization. **Nominations from individuals sponsoring their own names will not be considered.** The last date for receipt of nominations is **28 February 2002**. 1. Professor Hira Lal Chakravarty Award: Applications in prescribed forms are invited from Indian scientists, below 40 years of age as on 31 December 2001 with Ph.D. degree from any University or Institution in India, having significant contributions in any branch of **Plant Sciences**. The award is given for original independent published work carried out in India within three years prior to the award. The award carries a cash amount of Rs 4000 and a certificate. Awardee will be required to deliver a lecture on the topic of his/her specialization during the Annual Session of the Indian Science Congress in the Section of Plant Sciences. Last date for submitting application is 15 July 2002.

2. Pran Vohra Award: Applications in prescribed forms are invited from Indian scientists, below 35 years of age as on 31 December 2001 with Ph.D. degree from any University or Institution in India, having significant contributions in any branch of **Agriculture and Forestry Sciences**. The award is given for original independent published work carried out in India within three years prior to the award. The award carries a cash amount of Rs 10,000 and a certificate. Awardee will be required to deliver a lecture on the topic of his/her specialization during the Annual Session of the Indian Science Congress in the Section of Agriculture and Forestry Sciences. Last date for submitting application is 15 July 2002.
