The Program is available in the fields of Biochemistry, Biomaterials, Biomedical Engineering/Instrumentation, Cellular and Molecular Cardiology, Chronic Disease Epidemiology, Health Economics, Health Policy Analysis, Gender Issues in Health, Implant Biology, Medical Anthropology, Health System Research, Neurobiology, Neurology, Pathology, Polymer sciences, Radiology and Thrombosis research.

Candidates with Post Graduate Degree in Physics, Chemistry, Biochemistry/Biotechnology/Physiology/Zoology or any other branches of life sciences excluding plant sciences, M.Tech. in Polymer Technology/Material Science/Biomedical Engineering/Instrumentation or Post Graduate Degree in Public Health, Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy, Veterinary Sciences, Social Sciences or Statistics with at least 60% marks can apply. Selection will be on the basis of performance in a **Written test/Interview**. Those who have passed the UGC–CSIR National Eligibility Test/or hold individual fellowship can directly appear for interview. In the disciplines of Pharmacy and Engineering, only GATE-qualified candidates with percentile score of 85 and above are considered.
