RONPAKU programme provides tutorial and financial support to researchers who wish to obtain their Ph.D. degrees from Japanese universities through the submission of a dissertation, without going through a doctoral course. Grantees under the RONPAKU programme are required to conduct their dissertation research under the joint supervision of a Japanese Advisor and an Indian Advisor and are expected to obtain the Ph.D. degrees within five years.
