Earthwatch Institute, a non-profit organization that brings science to life for people concerned about the Earth's future is seeking to hire a Field Director to deliver a new *Field Research and Education Program*, in partnership with HSBC Bank and international NGOs. This global program aims to reduce the impacts of Climate Change on people and their livelihoods, by promoting action in the world's major ecosystems. Earthwatch is establishing Regional Climate Centres in UK, USA, Brazil, India and China. These will provide the base for the research program, which aims to engage HSBC employees and communities surrounding the centres in understanding and acting on climate change.

Responsibilities:

- Deliver the HSBC Climate Partnership program (a HSBC funded project till 2011) at the India Regional Climate Centre, overseeing the research and education program to achieve key performance indicators and ensure that the program achieves an ongoing environmental, economic and social legacy within the climate centre landscape.
- S/he will be a strategic member of Earthwatch India global team and work closely with the Country Director to develop the programmes of the organization in India. The incumbent will work in collaboration with pre-eminent research institutes working on action research projects in the Western Ghats. This research team will report results and successfully deliver the research program through teams of employee fellows.

Qualifications:

- Preferably a Ph.D. with a background in environmental action research (preferably in forest ecology), with at least 12–15 years of experience in strategic project operations & implementation.
- Skills in building & sustaining partnerships with multiple stakeholders – government, donors, project partners.
- Strong familiarity of environmental issues within the Western Ghats Area.
