Research Proposals Call for 29th and 30th Indian Scientific Expeditions to Antarctica (InSEA)

The National Centre for Antarctic and Ocean Research, an autonomous R&D Institution under the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India is the nodal agency responsible for the planning, co-ordination and implementation of Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica. The Twenty-ninth (29th) and Thirtieth (30th) Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica (InSEA) will be launched in November/December, 2009 and 2010 respectively. The summer team component of 29th and 30th InSEA shall return to India in March 2010/2011 whereas the winter team of 29th and 30th InSEA would return to India in March 2011 and 2012.

The thrust area of the 29th Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica shall be related to '**Climate Change**'. NCAOR welcomes scientific proposals which have linkages to climate change. In addition to the ongoing programmes of different institutions, NCAOR welcomes other scientific projects in different areas of science (Please refer Website).
